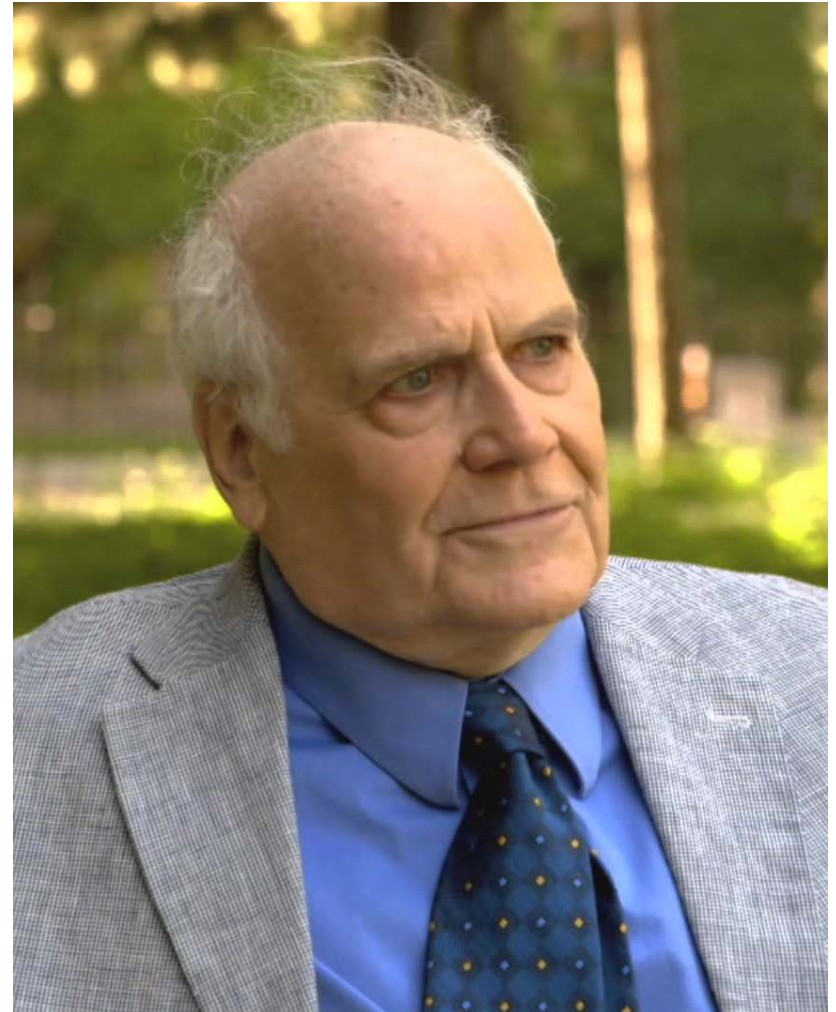

Canadian Parents for French is the largest Anglophone organization promoting French second-language education and opportunities in Canada

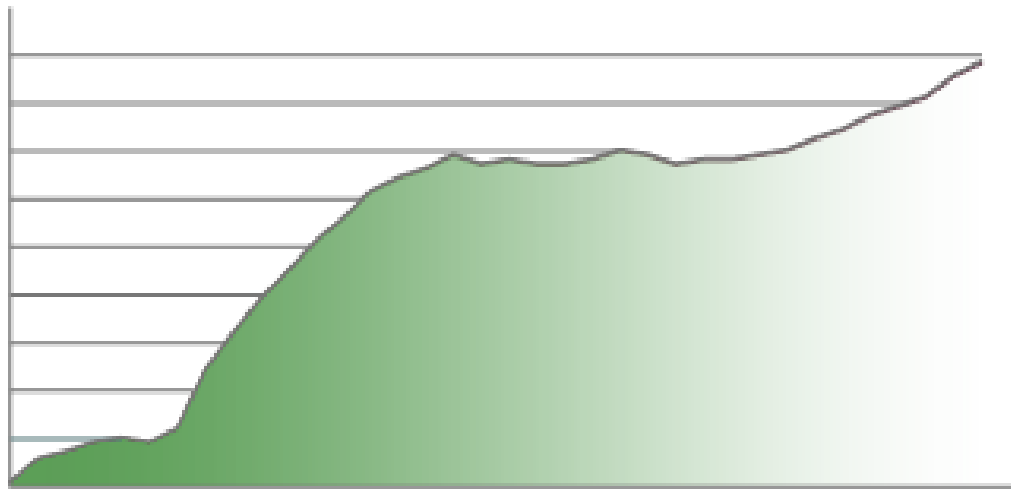

CPF behind expansion of French second-language in Canada

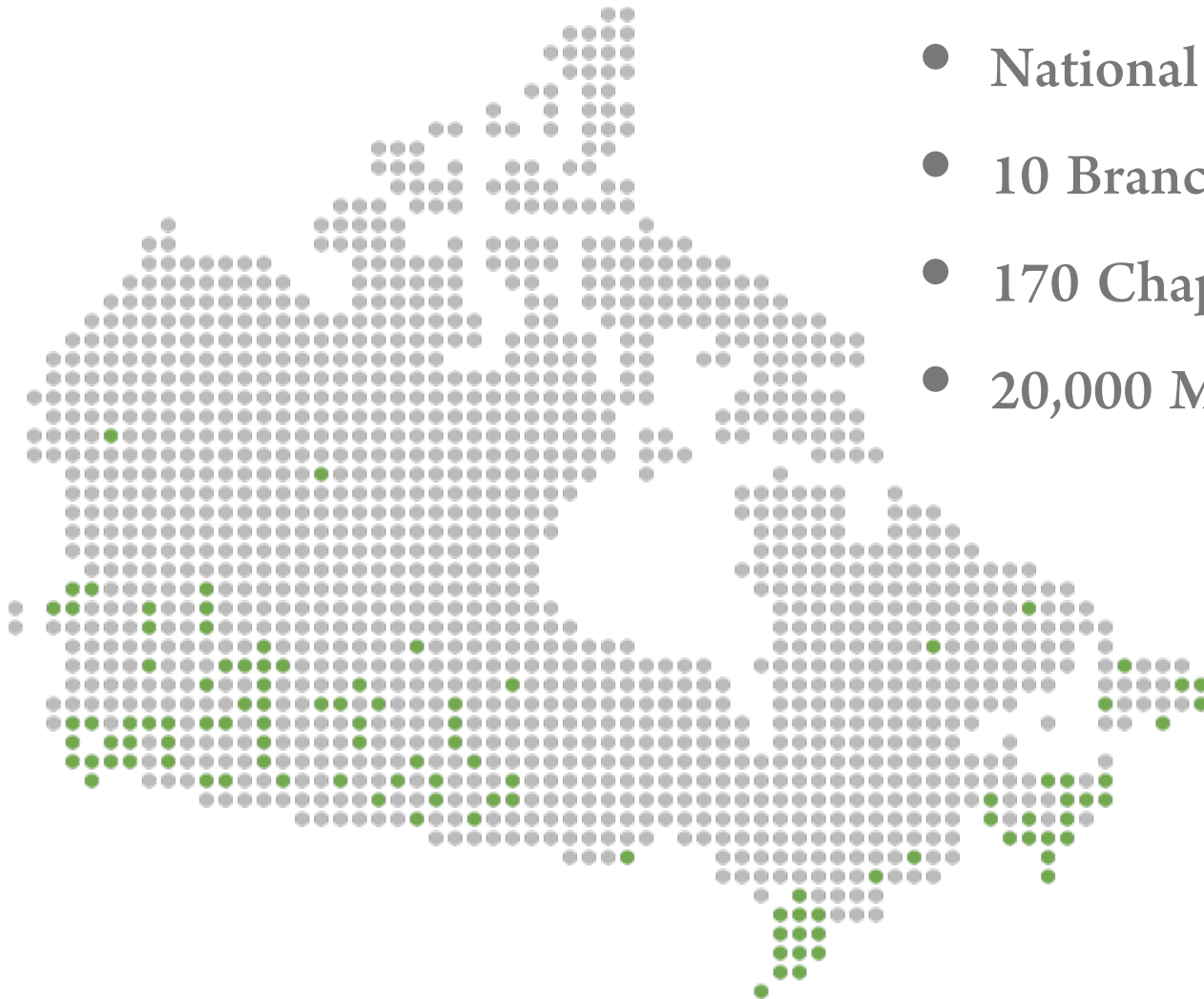
CONSISTENT FRENCH IMMERSION GROWTH



FRENCH IMMERSION ENROLMENT SINCE 1965

- 45,000 students in French Immersion in 1977
- 377,000 students in French Immersion in 2014
